52. Mary Angus and K. William LeQuier - **Readsboro Glassworks. Handblown, sandblasted and sculptural glass.** 6954 Main St., Readsboro VT 05350. (802) 423-7706. In Readsboro travel south on Rte. 100 (Main St.) and find us in the center of town, 3 doors past the Post Office on the same side of the street, lower floor.

53. Corner House Creations - Jane May Jones. Watercolors of architectural and garden elements. 1693 Branch Hill Rd, Readsboro VT 05350. (802) 423-7535. Also at this site: **South Hill Quilts - Norma Abel. Art quilts, wall hangings.** PO Box 283, Readsboro VT 05350. (802) 423-7693. Take Rte 100 south from Wilmington about 14 miles into Readsboro. Go past the Post Office on the left and take the 3rd left onto Branch Hill Rd. If you go by the Reads-

boro General Store, you have gone too far. Travel about 2 miles up the hill. Corner House Creations is located on the left of the T junction with West Hill and Bosley Hill Roads.

54. Shelli DuBoff - Pastel, watercolor, portraits, landscapes, animals. 2455 Monument Ave, Bennington VT 05201. (802) 442-2818. From the four corners of Main St in Bennington where Rtes 9 and 7 intersect, take Rte 7 south for about 2 miles. After you pass the Apple Valley Inn on the right, make a right hand turn at Carpenter Hill. Turn right immediately onto Monument Ave (going north behind the Apple Valley Inn.) After the first house on the left, a red cape, turn left onto the first gravel road marked by a mailbox with #2455 on it. Continue up the road for 0.25 miles. Studio will be on the left.

55. Tony Conner. Watercolor paintings. PO Box 1405, 206 Crescent Blvd, Bennington VT 05201. (802) 753-1156. From the east, west, and north, travel on Rtes 7 or 9 to the center of Bennington where Rtes 7 and 9 intersect. Turn south onto (or continue on) Rte 7 to Crescent Blvd on the left marked by a blinking yellow light. Turn left onto Crescent Blvd and go to the second house on the left. Studio is behind the house. Traveling north on Rte 7, as you approach Bennington, look for a blinking yellow light. Turn right at the blinker and go to the second house on the left with the studio behind the house.

56. Joshua Primmer - Contemporary ceramic art, sculptural and functional. 6 Gage Place, Bennington VT 05201. (802) 442-9901. In Bennington, heading east on Main St (Rte9) turn left onto Branch St. At the first stop sign turn right onto Gage St. Turn right onto Gage Place and find me at the second house on the right. Parking is limited, so park on Gage St. Handicapped parking available at the studio.

57. Judith Kniffin. Oils, watercolors, prints. PO Box 422, 11 Prospect St, North Bennington VT 05257. (802) 447-2553. Traveling north on Route 7 from the center of Bennington, continue onto the Rte. 7N limited access highway and at fork, bear left onto to Rte. 279. Take first exit for North Bennington. Turn left onto Northside Drive (Rte. 67A). Follow 67A, past Hannafords and Home Depot, for 1.5 miles. Bear right at intersection by old church undergoing reconstruction (still 67A, now called Water Street). Continue 1 mile to intersection at village edge. Turn right and drive 1/8 mile up Prospect Street, passing firehouse on left. Look for deep yellow house on your right, across from Mechanic Street intersection. Studio is upstairs in the detached garage. Traveling south toward Bennington on Route 7, take Bennington exit #1, onto Rte. 279. Take first exit off Rte. 279 for North Bennington. Turn left at exit onto Northside Drive and continue from directions above.

58. McAdoo Rugs - Jeff and Cary Turner. Hand hooked rugs, heirloom quality. PO Box 847, 1 Pleasant St, N. Bennington VT 05257. (802) 442-3563. Take Rte 7 north to the large intersection north of town. Turn left onto Rte 67A at the fourway light. Stay on Rte 67A past WalMart, Hannafords and Home Depot. Continue past the old mills on your right into the village of
