N. White River Craft Center, 50 Randolph Ave, Randolph VT 05060. (802) 728-8912.

199. Red House Studio - Linda Bryan. Fine art photography. 5225 Main St., Newbury VT 05051. (802) 866-9123. From I-91 north, take exit 16 and turn right onto Rte 25. At the traffic lights turn left onto Rte 5. Travel through Bradford Village and go north for 7 miles to Newbury. As you enter Newbury Village, my studio is the first red house on the right. From I-91 south, take exit 17 and turn left onto Rte 302 towards Wells River. Turn right onto Rte 5 and go south 5 miles to Newbury Village. My studio is on the left, past the Newbury Village Store.

200. West Wind Studio - Ricker Winsor. Oil paintings of Vermont landscape. PO Box 383, Bradford VT 05033. (802) 222-3389. Take I-91, Rte 5 or Rte 25 to Bradford and go straight into town. Follow Main St. north. At the end of the street, before going up a hill, turn left on Fairground Rd. Pass the elementary school, the armory and the town sheds and continue up the hill about 1.5 miles until you cross I-91. West Wind Studio is the third place on the left. Look for a large sign at driveway's entrance.

201. Sheepskin by Susan Bradford - Susan Bradford. Sheepskin hats and coats. 282 N. Main St., Bradford VT. 05033. (802) 222-4059. From I-91, take exit 16. Go right (east) on Rte. 25 to traffic light and turn left onto Rte. 5. Go through village of Bradford. Studio is the 5th building north of Bradford Academy on Rte. 5.

202. Bhakti Ziek - Weavings, wall-hangings, looms, TC-1, jacquard. 30 Highland Avenue, Randolph VT 05060. (802) 565-8880. On I-89 take exit 4 for Randolph and take Rte 66W to its junction with Rte 12 in town (stay left). On Main St. travel through downtown Randolph, cross the railroad track, to Highland Avenue. Turn left on Highland and go to the second stop sign. We are there at the intersection of Highland Avenue and Prospect Avenue. The house has a wrap around porch and a red roof.

203. White River Craft Center, Site A., Kimball House - Photography, weaving. 50 Randolph Ave, Randolph VT 05060. (802) 728-8912. Also at this location: **The Vermont Weaver's Guild. Handweaving.** (802) 728-3753. **Ken Goss - Photography, black and white, and color.** PO Box 201, Randolph VT 05060. (802) 728-4351. Take I-89 exit 4 and go west (downhill) on Rte 66 for 2.5 miles to the stop sign. Continue to the Cumberland Farms and bear left (Rte 12S) over the bridge and into Randolph.

At the end of the downtown block, turn left onto Merchant's Row and go to the stop sign. Proceed straight ahead onto Randolph Avenue. The White River Craft Center is on the hill straight ahead at 50 Randolph Ave. Parking is available up the driveway to the right of the WRCC sign.

204. White River Craft Center, Site B. Woodworking, stained glass, and pottery studios. 57-59 Weston St, Randolph VT 05060. David Hurwitz Originals - David Hurwitz. Furniture, lamps, mirrors, utensils, carving. 57 Weston St, Randolph VT 05060. (802) 728-9399. Kevin Harty - Handmade gallery furniture. 42 Randolph Ave, Randolph VT 05060. (802) 728-8912. Abby T Pottery - Abigail Tonks. Functional, wheelthrown, altered, stoneware pottery. 59 Weston St., Randolph VT 05060. (802) 728-3738. Atlantic Art Glass and Design - Phil Godenschwager. Stained glass, design, drawings. 3319 Fish Hill Rd, Randolph VT 05060. (802) 728-4414. On I-89 take exit 4 for Randolph and take Rte 66W (downhill) for 2.5 miles to the stop sign. Continue to the Cumberland Farms and bear left (Rte 12S) over the bridge and into Randolph. At the end of the downtown block, cross the railroad tracks. The second right hand turn at the movie theater is Weston St. Find the woodworking studio in the long red building at #57 and the pottery and stained glass studios on the right, which is yellow and gray.
