

VT 05841. (802) 533-7120. Travel from Stowe on Rte 15 through the center of Hardwick. Go 3 miles to Rte 16. Turn left and travel five miles to Bend Road on the left. Turn onto Bend Rd and go to the end, 3 miles. Turn right onto East St and go 0.1 mile to my drive on the left. Turn left up driveway (#165) and my studio/house is at the top of the hill.

**188. Deborah Holmes Watercolors - Deborah Holmes. Watercolors, prints of farms, flowers and villages.** Lakeview Inn, 295 Breezy Ave., Greensboro VT 05841. (802) 533-2597. Travel on Rte 14 to Hardwick from Woodbury. At the blinking light in the center of town Rte 14 swings to the left but you continue straight. Turn right at the Police Station onto Center Rd and go for 5 miles. At the four corners, go straight. Lakeview is one mile on the right, coming down the hill into the village. Parking is at the inn sign out front.

**189. Jennifer Ranz - Greensboro Barn - Jennifer Ranz. Pottery, porcelain jewelry, sculpture, watercolors.** 491 Country Club Road, Greensboro VT 05841. (802) 533-9281. In Hardwick, from Rte. 15 (Main St.) bear left at laundromat, go over bridge and up a small hill. Turn right at the Police Station, onto Church St. Follow this road, which turns into Center Rd, about 6 miles. When the speed limit reduces to 30, before Greensboro Village, take a sharp right onto Country Club Rd. Go 0.5 miles past the club. The Greensboro Barn is visible on the left.

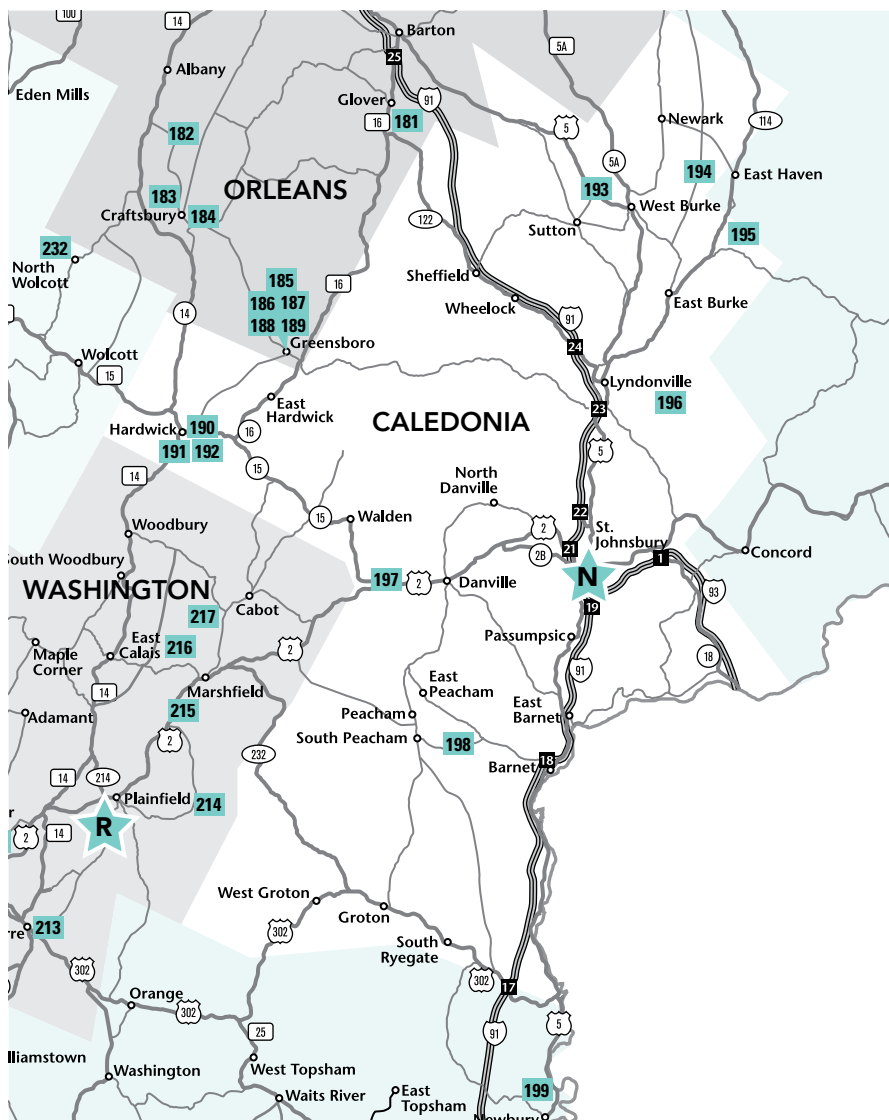

**190. Vermont Glass Workshop - Harry and Wendy Besett. Functional and Decorative Handblown Glass.** 482 Mackville Rd, Hardwick VT 05843. (802) 472-5733. From Hardwick going south on Rte 14, Main St, turn left on Mackville Rd and travel for 0.5 miles. Studio is on the right.

**191. Charuby Studios - Ruby Leslie. Handwoven scarves, shawls, and woven commissions. Ken Leslie. Artist's books and paintings.** 244 Carey Rd, Hardwick VT 05843. (802) 472-6375. From Hardwick village, go 1 mile south on Rte 14S. Turn left onto Carey Rd at the creme stand, across from the Mobil Station. Our studios are 1/4 mile up Carey Rd on the right. Park at the top of the driveway and enjoy the gardens.

**192. Lucian Avery Blacksmith - Lucian Avery. Thumblatches, hinges, fire tools, gates.** 736 Mackville Rd, Hardwick VT 05843. (802) 472-3899. From the blinking light at the junction of Rtes 14 and 15 in Hardwick go south 0.5 mile on Rte 14, then left onto Mackville Rd. Studio is 0.7 miles up Mackville Rd on the right.

**193. High Beams - Trenny Robb and Bob Michaud. Unique, copper, brass, botanical, lighting.** 29 Michaud Drive, Sutton VT 05867. (802) 467-3943. From West Burke, travel north on Rte 5 for 2.3 miles. Turn right onto Michaud Dr., and go about 100 ft to the first left. Find the shop on the right with a big wraparound porch.



**194. Maple Ridge Gallery - Nancy Reid. Jewelry, crafts, paintings.** 1713 Maple Ridge Rd, Newark VT 05871. (802) 467-8400. Take I-91 north to exit 23. In Lyndonville, take Rte 5 north. At the light, turn right onto Rte 114 and cross the bridge, RR tracks, and small bridge. Turn left up Darling Hill and stay on this road for 5 miles (it will turn to gravel) to the intersection with Burke Hollow Rd. Continue straight onto Burke Green Rd which will change to Maple Ridge Rd and travel for another 5 miles. Find us in a converted barn at 1713 Maple Ridge Rd.

**195. Sanderson's Wooden Bowls - Sam and Weeza Sanderson. Bowl turning.** 2902 VT Rte. 114, East Burke VT 05832. (802) 626-9622. On I-91 take exit 23 and head north on Rte. 5, through the village of Lyndonville. At the northern end of town, bear right onto Rte. 114 and go north to the village of East Burke. Continue past the village on Rte. 114 for about 2.5 miles. Look for a white farmhouse with red barn on the right with donkeys and a Sanderson's Wooden Bowls sign in front.
