

Accepting Payments at the Studio

Especially if you have higher priced work for sale, make it easy for people to pay you via credit card or a cash app.

Use cash apps including Venmo, Zelle, Apple Pay, Paypal, Cash App.

You will have to sign up and link the bank account that you want to receive \$ to the application. If you download the app to your phone or tablet, customers can pay you wirelessly. Search for info about each option to decide what is best for you.

Print out QR Codes for Payment and post in the sales area of your studio.

1. Open the app and click on “me”, on the bottom right of your screen. This brings up your Profile page.
How to do this with Venmo:

2. You'll see your picture (if you've added that to your account) in the center/top of your screen. There should be an icon overlapping the lower right of your picture. Click on your picture.

3. This brings you to a screen with your picture in the middle of a QR code. There are action icons beneath it, for downloading, emailing or printing a PDF of your QR code.
