It is no secret that the changes at the national level have caused a great deal of uncertainty for small businesses and the arts community. The dramatic advances in AI technology continue to reshape the role of human workers.

Against this background, we see Vermont arts businesses turning away from national markets and embracing what is near at hand. We've seen this in the huge jump in new participants in our Vermont Fall Open Studio, just concluded.

This underscores the importance of the work the Vermont Crafts Council is doing to support both emerging artists of all ages and established professionals. We need a greater capacity to help our community of small arts businesses. We need more administrative help to onboard new members, create and tailor workshops to strengthen their arts marketing and build local communication networks for individual artists and craftspeople.

Our hardworking (unpaid) board is currently digging deep to assist the VCC part time Executive Director.

We are fundraising \$20,000 to support an additional paid position to help bring VCC up another level.

As this turbulent year draws to a close, I am reaching out to you to ask for your help to meet this goal for the coming year.

What we did in 2025:

- Invested in online subscriptions to streamline accounting and task management.
- Added **new benefits for members** on our website, including a page for those who offer wholesale prices and a google map highlighting artists who teach.
- Produced a **free arts marketing day** in partnership with the White River Craft Center.
- Expanded our Zoom arts business offerings from six to eight.
- Provided individual support to artists new to Open Studio Weekend.
- **Developed new revenue streams**, including creating opportunities for businesses to sponsor our programming.
